This collection contains the unique sound of this lovely little steam train - featuring chuffing through railroad crossings, funny sounding whistles, rail clatter, and the creaking of wooden wagons. Takes include riding, idling, drive-bys, departing and arriving trains, rattling squeaking, clacking, coupling, bells, whistles, and air releases.

It was a challenging shoot since this Train drives only in summertime, and we struggled with birdsong and crowds. We had to repeat the recordings several times to give you the cleanest possible recordings for your project.
