About the 9972xx

This collection gathers the heavy, powerful sounds of a 9972xx, and the clatter, rattle, and grinding of wagons.

Highlights are the fast and heavy pass-bys, recorded at several isolated places in the Harz mountain range of Germany, resulting in very clean recordings with impressive long tails of steam engine sound. Takes also include idling, approaching, departing, and arriving trains.

The riding recordings were made in different locations of the train such as the engine, between the wagons and in the compartment.




